
**Inspection report regarding the checking of compliance report – matter regarding grant of extension/continuation in provisional in MBA and MCA programs at Rattan Institute of Management, Village Harphala, Ballabhgarh, Faridabad for the session 2024-25.**

The Inspection Committee consisting of the following visited the above said college on 22.11.2024 for checking of compliance report – matter regarding grant of extension/continuation in provisional in MBA and MCA programs at Rattan Institute of Management, Village Harphala, Ballabhgarh, Faridabad for the session 2024-25.

**Observations of the Committee:** The inspection committee physically inspected and verified the infrastructural facilities viz. Buildings, various Laboratories, Library, Classrooms/Tutorial Rooms, Furniture, Amenities including Faculty and Non-Teaching Staff, etc. for the above mentioned program/courses. On the basis of inspection, the observations of the committee are as under:

1. **Compliance:** The college has partially satisfied the conditions imposed by the previous inspection committee and the following issue/compliance which are partially not complied yet are as under:
  - a. The college has not yet got approval of Board of Governors/Governing Body by university and not taken nominee from University.
  - b. Not even a single faculty member including Principal/Director and non-teaching staff and support staff is approved by university. Neither appointment approved nor proceeding approved by the university. All faculty members, non-teaching staff and support staff are appointed at college level only.
2. **AICTE Approval:** The college has already obtained the extension of approval from AICTE (EoA) for session 2024-25 for the following programs:  
MBA - 120 seats  
MCA - 120 seats
3. **Faculty and Staff:** The College has appointed 1 Principal and 24 faculty members (MCA- 1 Professor, 2 Associate Professor, 9 Assistant Professors and MBA - 1 Professor, 2 Associate Professor, 9 Assistant Professors) for these programs at its own/college level. The college has appointed 18 non-teaching/support staff for various programs at college level. But till date none of the faculty and staff approved by the university. Neither appointment approved nor proceeding approved by the university. The college should expedite the process of approval of appointment and



proceeding approvals of various teaching and non-teaching staff appointed from the university at the earliest within 3 months.

4. **Building:** The college has a 2-storey buildings having Class/ rooms, Seminar Hall, Class room, Computer Labs, Director/Principal Office, HoD Office, Faculty Cabins, Library and other required amenities for the aforesaid programs. The college has adequate power backup/generators. Proper lifts/ramp and washrooms for disabled person/students should be installed.
5. **Computational Facilities & Laboratories:** The College has adequate computing facilities with 150 Computers, 4 Printers, Internet facility with 100 MBPS and has required softwares for said programs. The college has to procure more advanced equipments and legal softwares for these programs as per university syllabi.
6. **Library:** The College has a library having 1128 books for these programs. Besides, these the college has National Journals, International Journals, Magazines and Newspapers in the library. The college's website is working. The college has to procure more standard books as per latest Syllabi of various programs.
7. **Amenities:** The College has almost all general amenities on the campus such as canteen, playground, seminar hall, conference rooms, park, power backup/generators, drinking water, washrooms, sitting area and parking etc. The college is advised to maintain proper amenities and infrastructure.
8. **Governing Body:** The College has to constitute the BoG as per University norms and take nominee and get approval from university at the earliest.
9. **NBA/NAAC:** College is not accredited by NAAC/NBA. The College be advised apply for NAAC and NBA for ensuring quality education.


### Recommendations:






